## E# 2013-2014

As in previous seasons, I'll be updating the E# for all the teams in the Championship this year. If you've not seen it before, this is essentially how it works:

## "E#" is the "Elimination Number" for each team that is not leading the league.

The elimination number of each team can be defined as:

- "The combined number of:
- a) wins for the leading team and
- b) defeats for the specific trailing team

that are required for that trailing team to be unable to overhaul the leader"

This means any win for the leading team reduces all E#s by one. Any defeats suffered by trailing teams reduce their own E# by one.

So a win for the leader combined with a defeat for a trailing side would reduce their E# by 2. A defeat for the leader and a win for a trailing side would leave their E# unchanged.

(As a win is worth 3 points and a draw is worth 1, a draw for the leading team reduces all other E#s by a third. A draw for any trailing side reduces their own E# by two thirds.)

## **Changes for 2013-2014**

There are 3 'vital' boundaries in the league, i.e: 1st/2nd (Champions/2nd)
6th/7th (Playoffs/No Playoffs) and
21st/22nd (Safety/Relegation)

With this in mind, I've made 3 tables (above). The team or teams lying ABOVE the border (darker shading) have an E# that represents the number of appropriate results that will ENSURE a final position of Winners/Playoff spot/Safety.

I've also put the E# tables alongside a current actual league table for easy comparison.
