





Ideas:

Cut thin copper or aluminum foil and glue that card stock or chipboard. Engrave or emboss as you like.

Skip the foil and print colors or patterns on card or paper. Add a name, a picture of a child or pet.

If you like to work with clay you can cut a base shape like a square or a circle and embellish it with clay. Glue a faux wood (polymer clay) frame to the base and add a picture. Or turn a circle into a daisy or a happy face, etc.




Lots of great things can be made with this idea.

You can recreate the shape using card or chipboard. Then you can customize the art in a thousand ways.

You can embellish these with clay, ribbon, lace, straw, tiny flowers, etc, etc, etc.

Note that you can also forego the hole for adding a cord and instead glue a pin back on it to create a pin / brooch.

And if you prefer, you can cut short lengths of coffee stirrer tubes and then glue or tape those to the back of your shapes. Add some elastic cord and create customized bracelets.



A while back I experimented with making some alcohol inks.

I bought several small plastic squeeze bottles with dropper caps. At the \$ Store I bought a couple of packs of childrens' markers. I opened the markers and took the ink felt out and put it into a small cup and added alcohol to it. I let that set for a day and then poured the homemade ink into the squeeze bottles. Worked well.

Here's an idea: cut these circles from chipboard. Then use alcohol inks on white sticker paper. Cut the sticker paper to fit the chipboard circles and stick it on. Use some fabric or ribbon as a bail and add a chain or cord.



While this is a card, it is pretty enough to be jewelry.

You could make this in a small size and add a bail at the top to create a pendant.

Or you can cut out some butterflies and glue them onto a paper pendant or some paper earrings.




Floral Pendant Necklace

This one was made with polymer clay but you could use, for instance, a gray paper background and then cut and glue colorful swirls, flowers, shapes, paw prints, etc.

Sky's the limit on this one.



Here's an idea I'll bet you did not think of...

Making a locket that looks like a small picture album. Make it so it folds to open and close and use a tiny bit of velcro to hold it closed. Other ideas for the closure include post-it sticky, repositionable glue or a small elastic band that is attached at the back of the album.



Using your Cameo to engrave stuff.


