







Love Bird Card Directions



Flip Back support over and glue to back of front, but don't glue circle. You will glue this area after the swing has been put through the two slits.




Connect glued Front/Back (A) to unglued Front (B) so that slots (c & d) match up by slipping (B) over (A). Flip Back support (B) over and glue to back of front (B) while the two hearts are together.




Glue the two together to strengthen the swing


When Heart A & B are joined, you can attach the swing by slipping it through the two slits on top, enabling to swing back and forth. Then carefully glue the circle without getting glue on the swing.



Main Fence



Back (Looking at it from the front of the fence.)




Fold the fence up and glue. The slots should match.

Heart (A)

Heart (B)

Match the letter/number on the *inner pieces* to the fence letter/number. Work the H-A, H-B, F2,F1, B2,B1 first and then work on the remaining pieces. Once the heart and inner pieces have been attached, you can glue the back fence to the tabs on the main fence.




Inner pieces

Hooks. Gently fold bottom part of tab up and push through slots in the fence. Once through fence fold tab back down.

Only cut out the bird's back (not front). Then piece layers (not including feet) onto the front of the bird's back as shown. The finished birds, without their feet, get glued to the back of the swing and then glue the feet onto the front of the swing.



Tag for front and back.



Put ribbon or twine through holes so that the tag will hang just above the bottom of the fence. Use a pop dot or foam to attach (A) to (B).
