

A Few Methods and Apps for Resizing:

Android **Apps:** *Image Size/Image Shrink Lite* Free, set pixel size once. Resize 1 photo at a time.

iOS Easiest way to resize a phone photo is to email your photo to yourself. Go to your Photo App and select the photo. Tap the "share" option and choose mail. List your email address as the recipient. Tap "send" and then choose "medium". You can process 5 photos at a time. The original photo will remain reduced.

Apps: *Image Size* Free and easy. Resize 1 photo at a time. Set pixel size once.
CropSize Free, but more steps required. Resize multiple photos at once.
Desqueeze Free. Resize multiple photos at once.

PCs

Windows: After moving your photos to your PC, save a photo to your desktop. Right click on the photo and select "edit" then "resize," and fill in "Pixels." Save the resized photo.

Apps: *Image Resizer for Windows 10* Free. Resize to 800 wide, save, rename.
Online: *Photosize.com* Free, very easy.

MAC: Apple Photos App

1. Create a folder on the desktop to hold exported and resized photos.
2. Open the Photos App, left click to select the photos to export for resize.
3. Next select File menu, then Export, then Export "x" photos.
4. From the export option of image size, select "medium".
5. Export to your desktop folder.

If your photos are already exported, you can resize with the **Preview** App. (Make a copy to save the original photo as it will be permanently altered.)

1. Open the photo in the PREVIEW app.
2. Next, select 'Tools' then select 'Adjust Size'.
3. Enter a preset of 640 x 480 or you can enter your own custom size.
4. Save.
