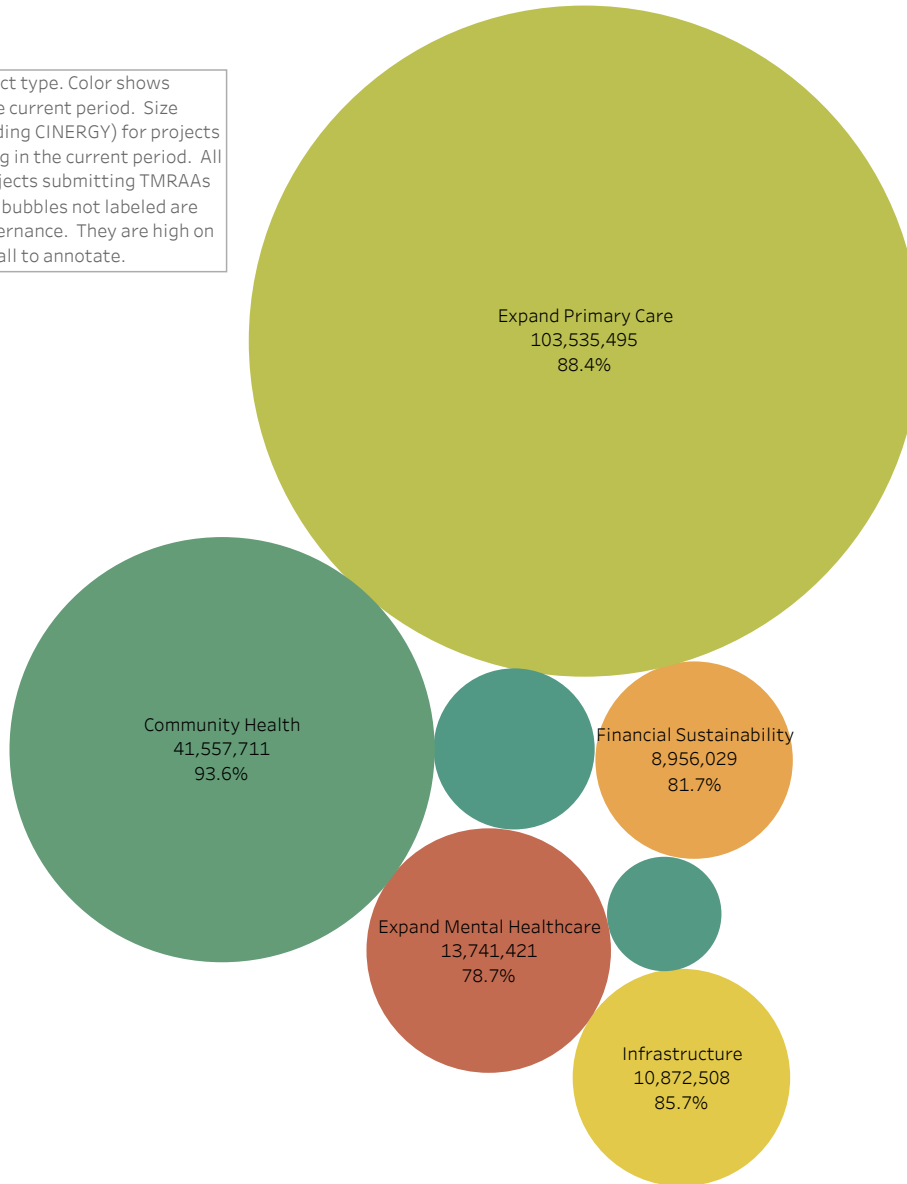


First we looked at how VAP funding is distributed by Project type and how well those projects are performing relatively

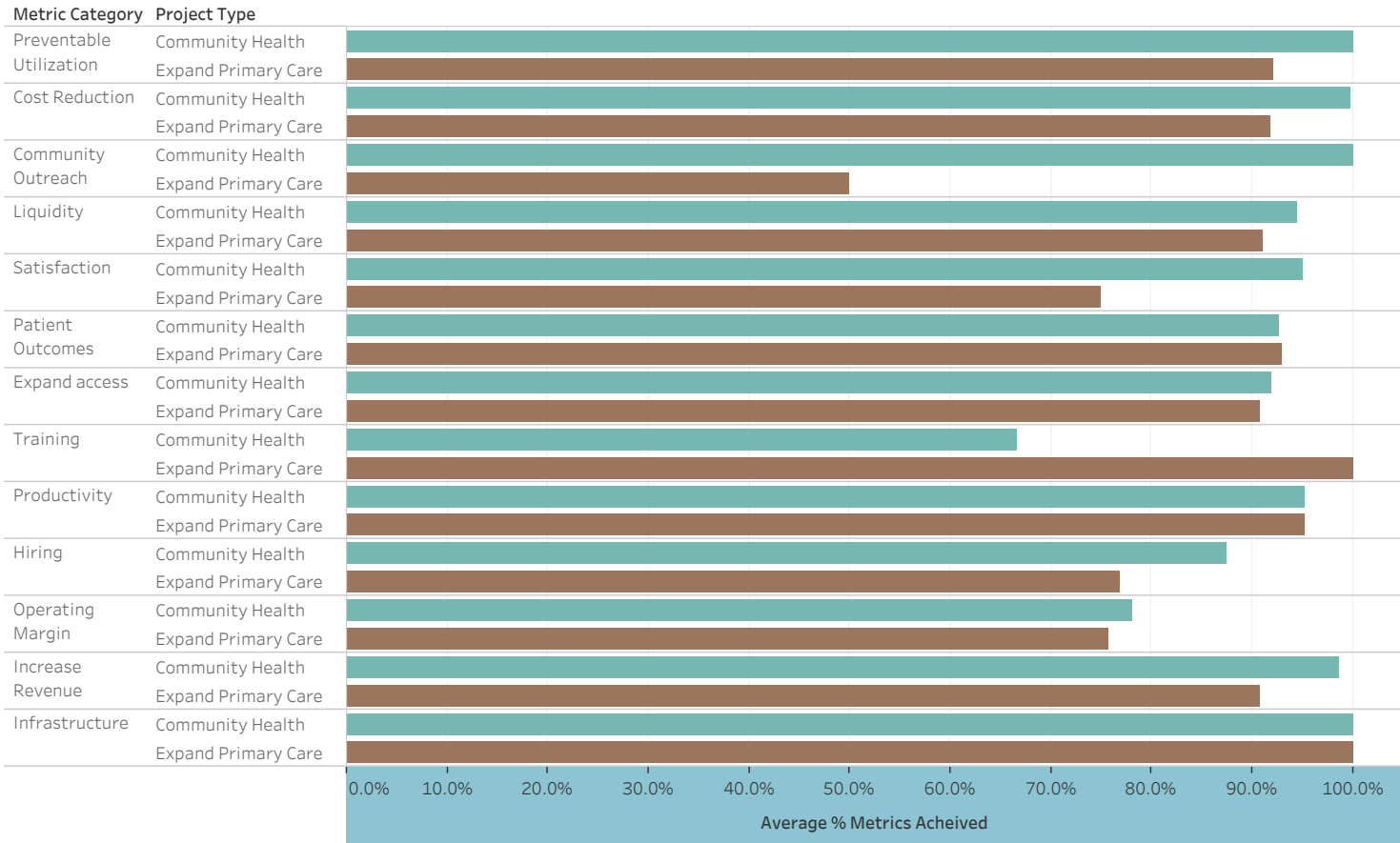
Expanding Primary Care and Community Health are the two areas with highest investments. What is driving better metric achievement in Community Health projects

Each circle is a grouping by project type. Color shows average of metric achieved in the current period. Size shows sum of VAP Award (Excluding CINERGY) for projects in that project category reporting in the current period. All data as of 3/31/2017 for any projects submitting TMRAAs in the current period. Two small bubbles not labeled are Financial Sustainability and Governance. They are high on metrics achievement but too small to annotate.
