How to check for the windows version:

Click on the start button and type in *Command prompt* and press the enter key.

In the DOS window type *ver* and enter

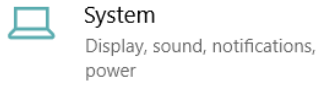
This will display your current windows version and build numbers.

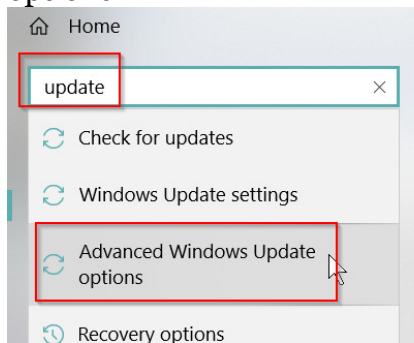
How to check for update settings:

Click on the start button and type the word *settings* and press the enter key
