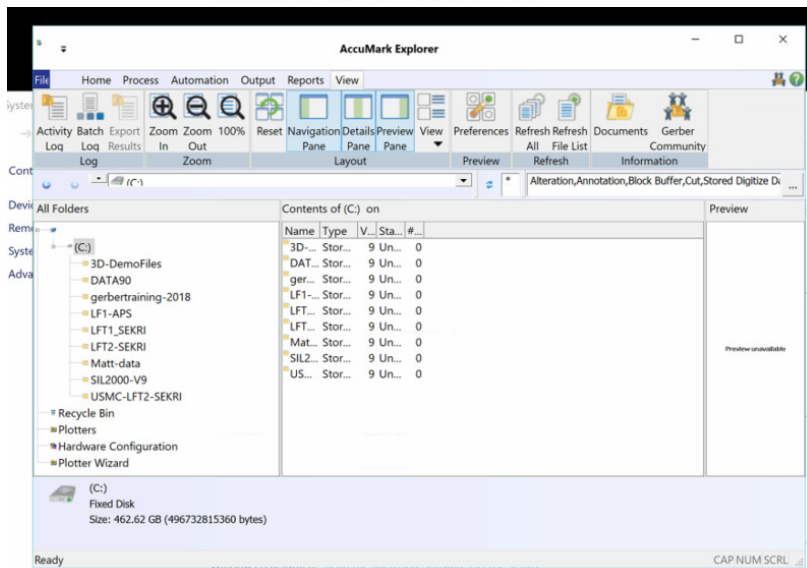
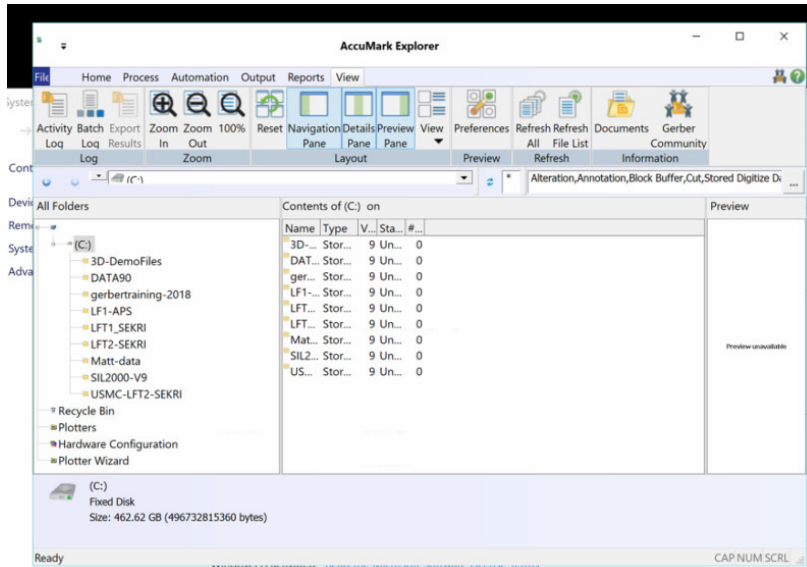


Issues with 4 K monitors:

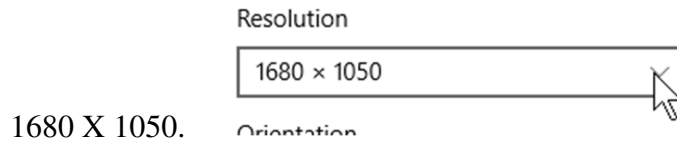
4K resolution or also known as 4K refers to a horizontal resolution of approximately 4,000 pixels. The resolution settings are usually set at 3840X2160 or higher than 1920X1080. These monitors may also be referred to high pixel density displays. If you are not sure of your monitor type look at the resolution.

If you have a 4K monitor your icons in AccuMark explorer may seem very small, as will the icon menu in Pattern Design. You may also notice the AccuMark explorer and Pattern Design splash screen will appear very small.

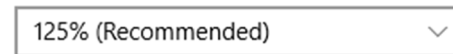
1. Adjust the resolution: Choose a lower resolution a recommended setting is 1680X1050. Don't set the resolution too low, this can make icons look blurry and affect the stability of the graphic drivers. To change the resolution on windows 10 operating system right click on the desktop and select Display Settings, scroll down to the resolution and select



2. Scale and layout: Next change the size of text, apps and other items, once you change the resolution it will show what is recommended which for 1680 X 1050 125% is recommended.
