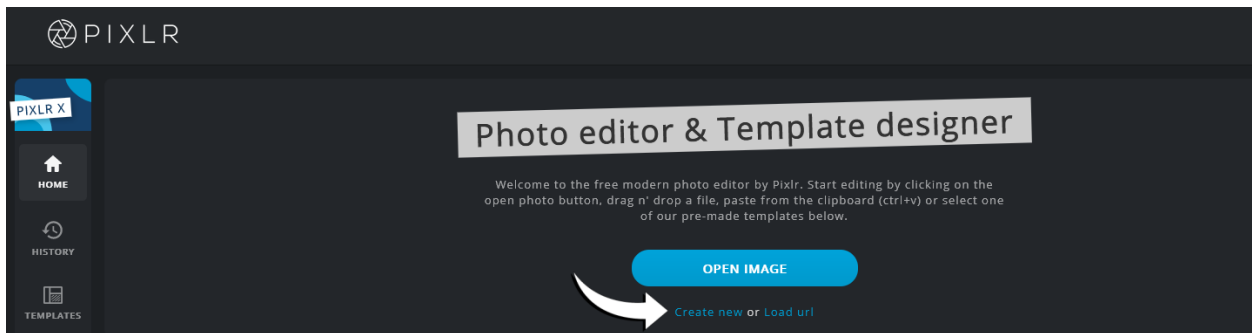


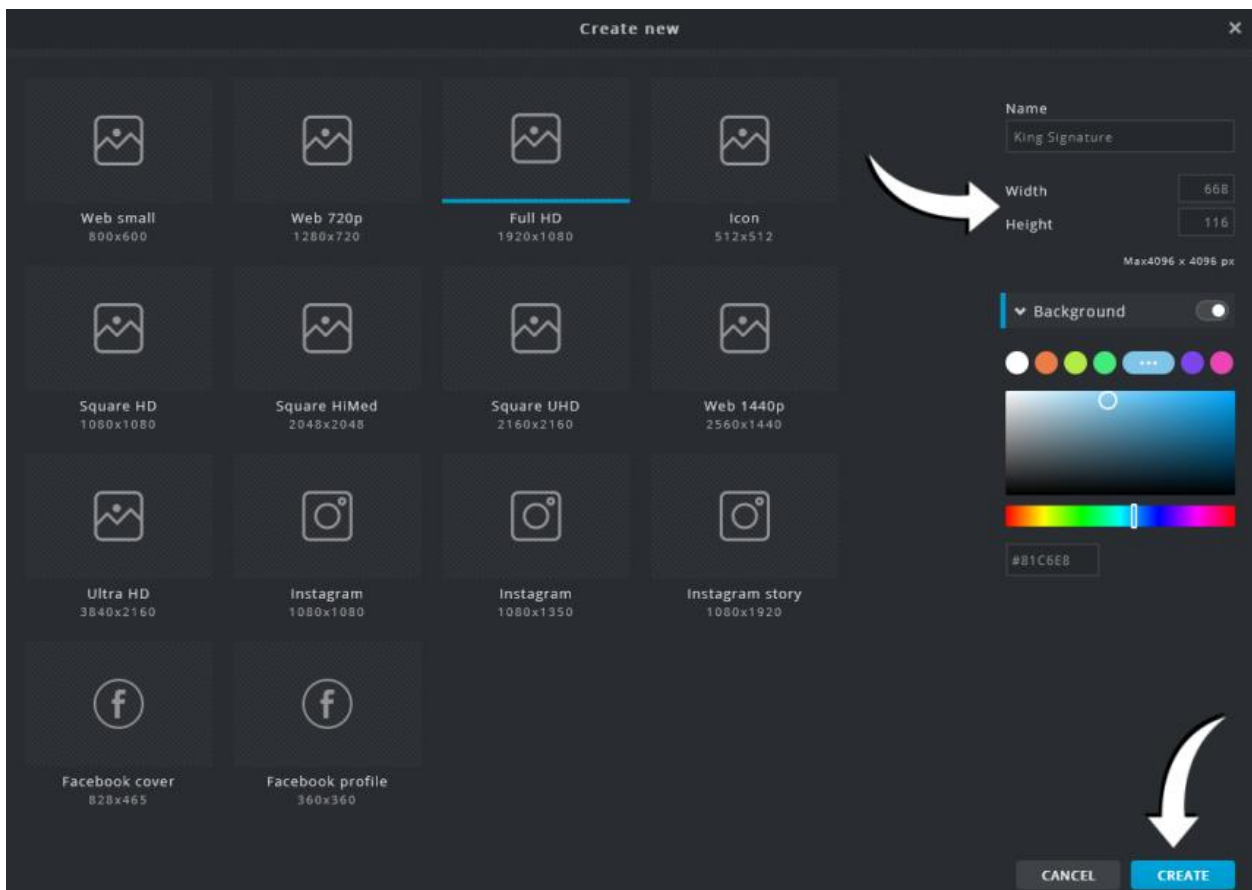
How to create your own signature



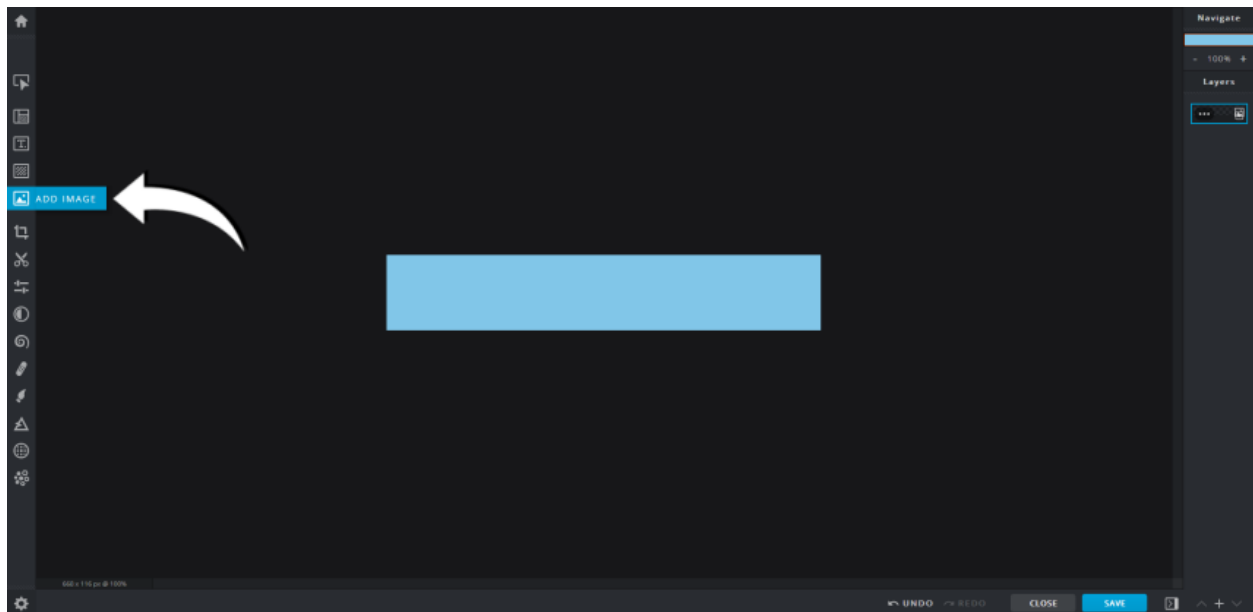
Type this into the web browser search bar - <https://pixlr.com/x/>



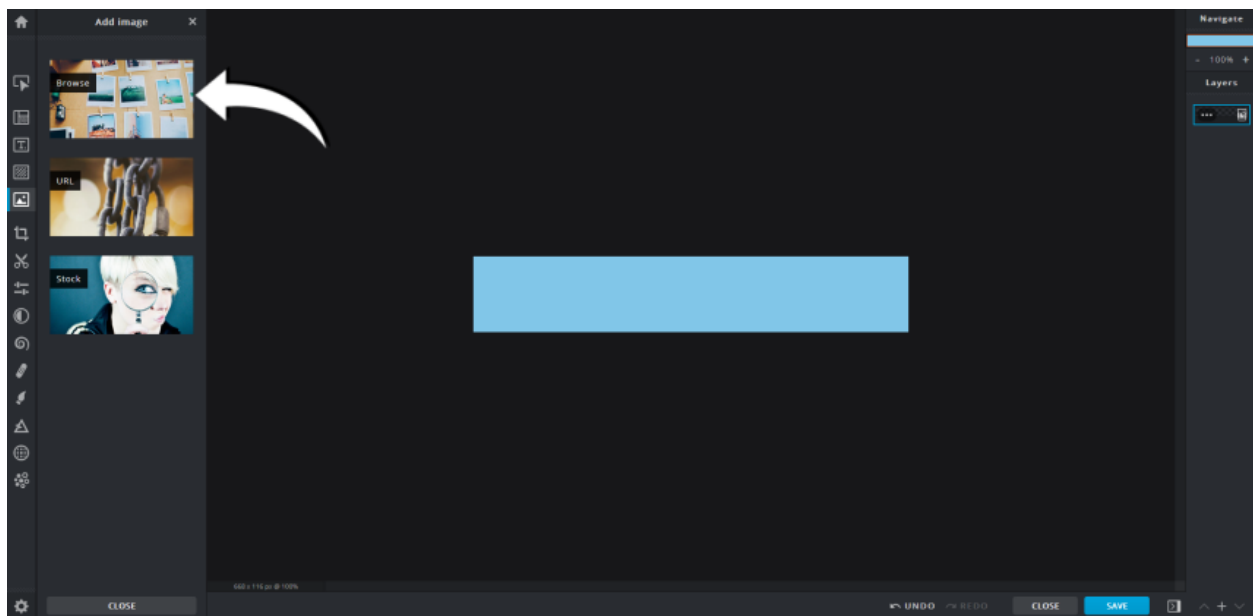
1.- Click on **Create new**



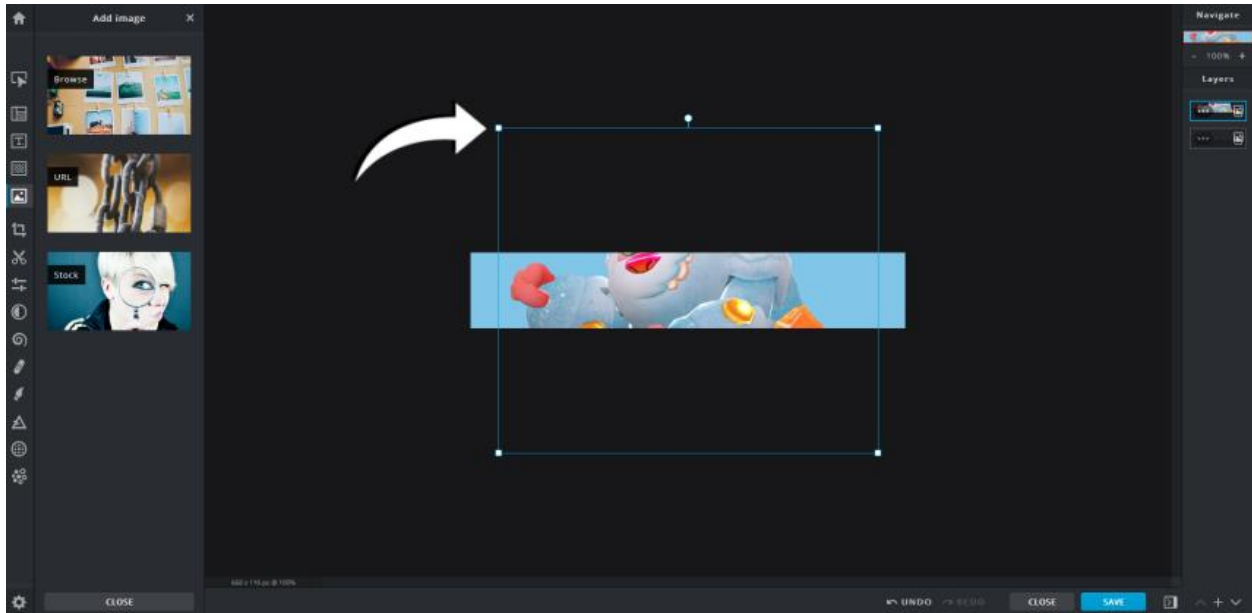
- 2.- Give this image a **name**, choose pixel width (**668**) and height (**116**) and choose **background color**
- 3.- Click on **CREATE** on the bottom right



- 4.- From the tools located on the left side click on the **ADD IMAGE**

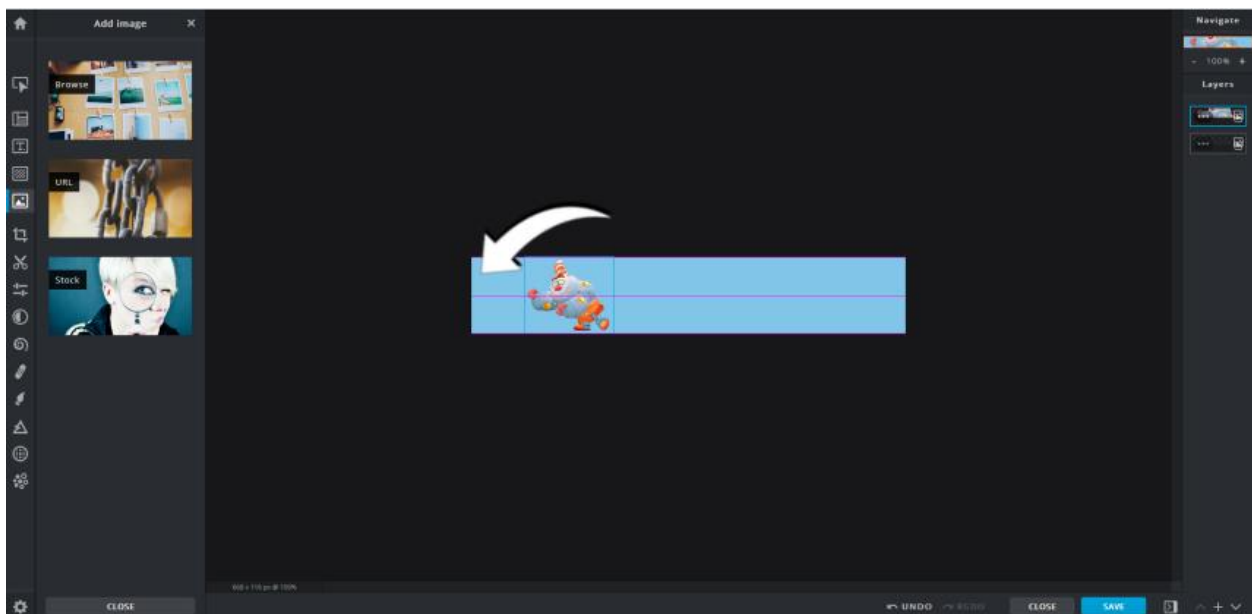


- 5.- Click on the **Browse** tab and it will open to where you have your images located
- 6.- Click on the image that you want to add and open it

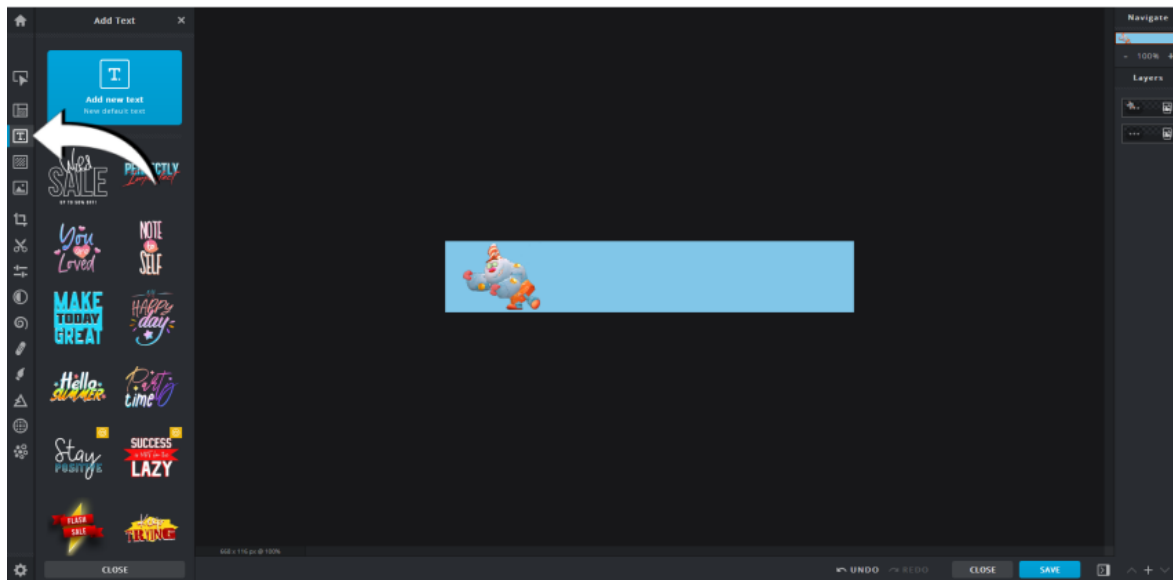


7.- Resize your image by going to the top left side of the image and dragging it which will create a smaller image

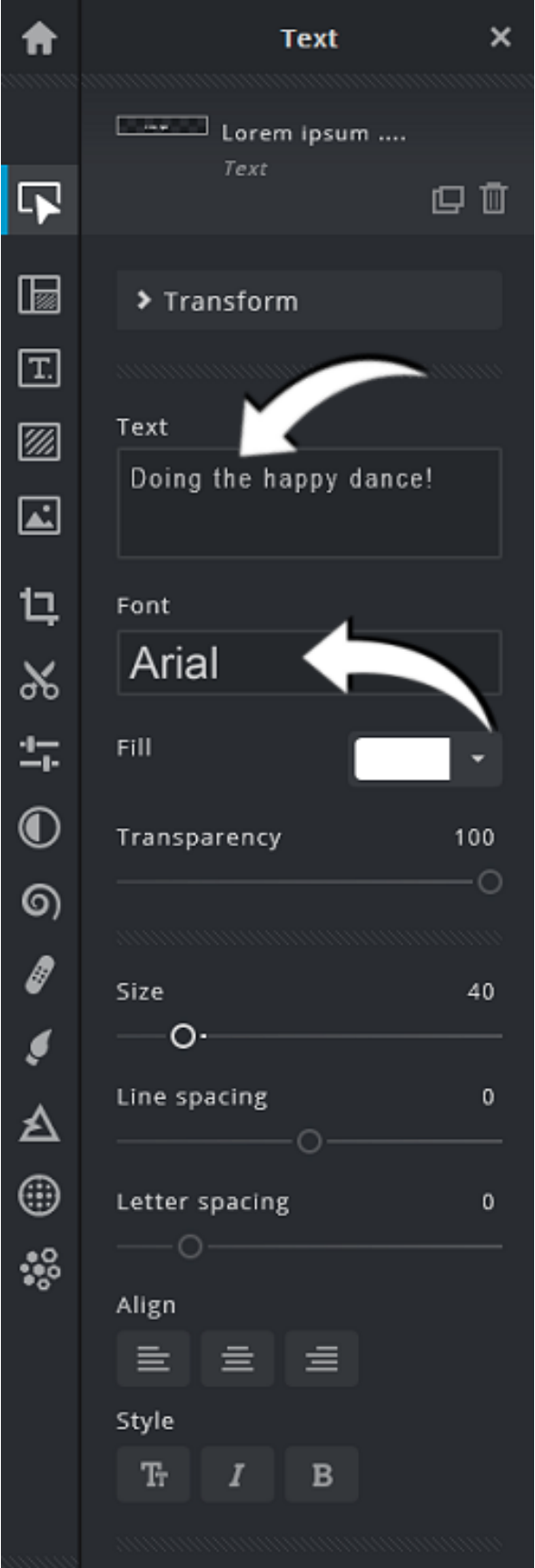
8.- Keep dragging it and you might have to move the resizing box a bit higher so that you can view the image



9.- Once your image is the size that you want, move it to the designated area

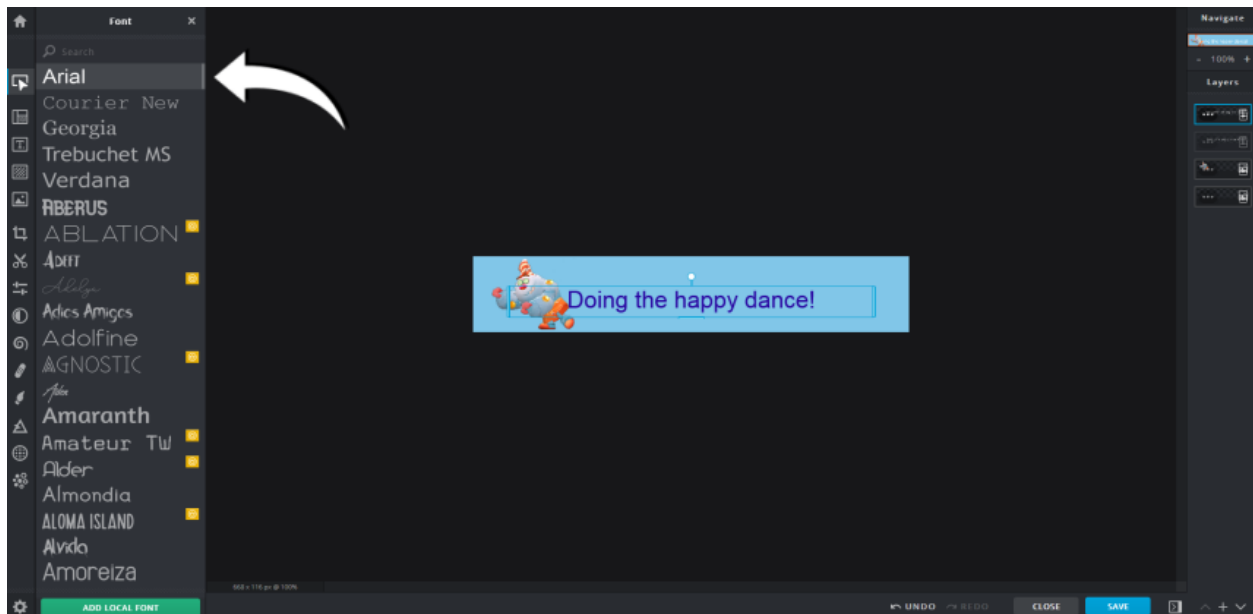


- 10.- Click on the **ADD TEXT** from the tools on the left side
- 11.- Click on the **Add new text** in the blue box

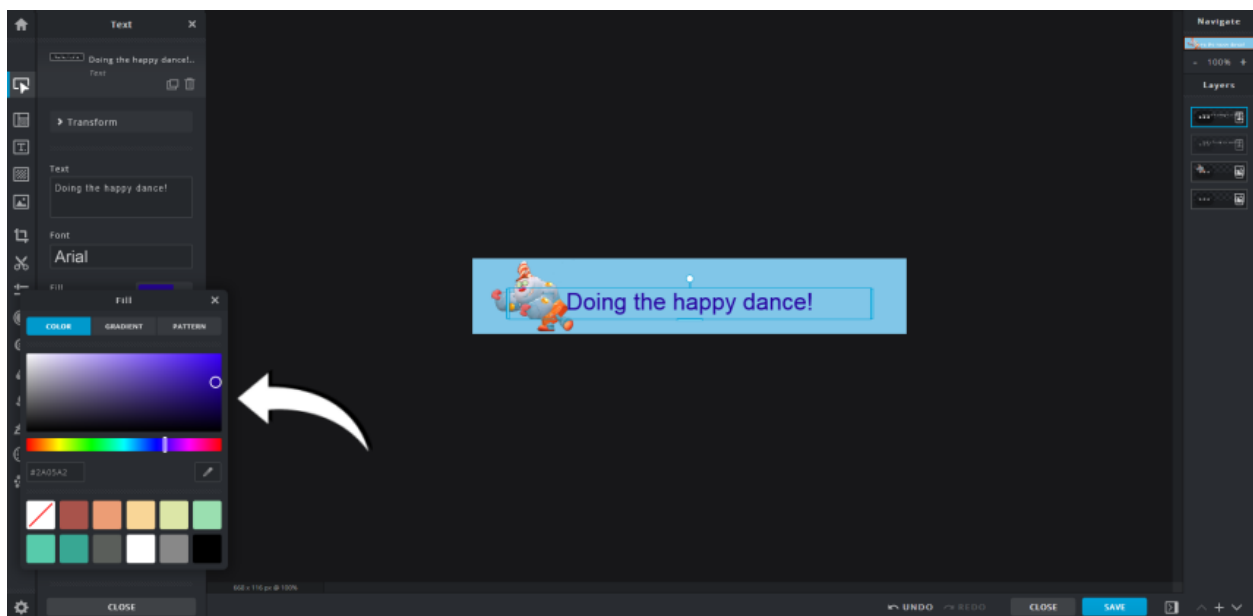


12.- Type in your text in the text box

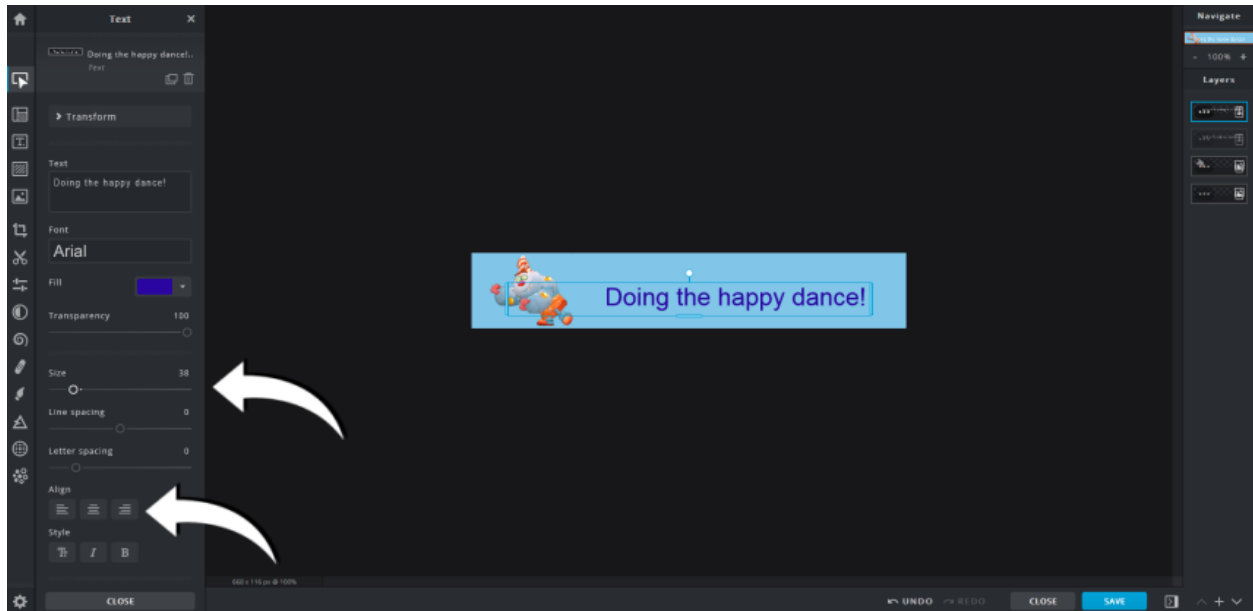
13.- Click on the text area and a drop menu will open



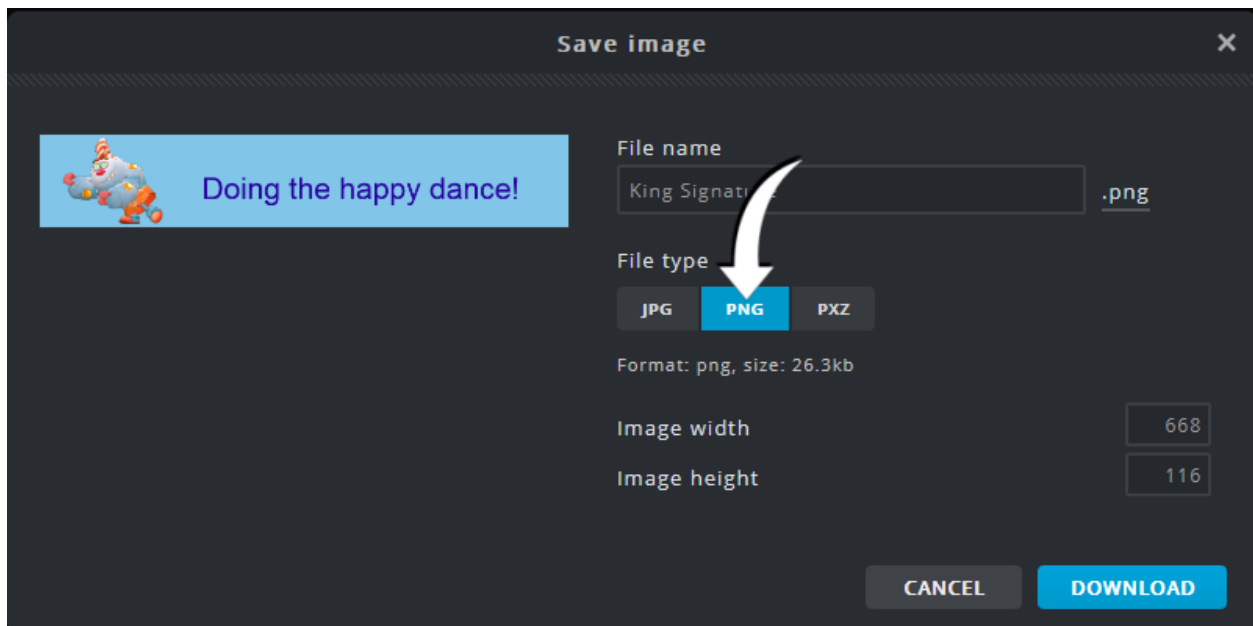
13.- Choose font type from this drop down box



14.- Choose the font color – move the circle or the slide bar to change the color



- 15.- Choose font size by sliding the circle to the desired size
- 16.- Choose alignment or move it on your own
- 17.- Click on the **SAVE** on the bottom right



- 18.- Click on file type and choose **PNG** –this image type can be opened in all graphic programs
- 19.- Click on **DOWNLOAD**
- 20.- Click on **SAVE FILE** and then **CLOSE**

21.- Locate the image in Windows Explorer **DOWNLOAD** folder

And you now have your own signature!
