

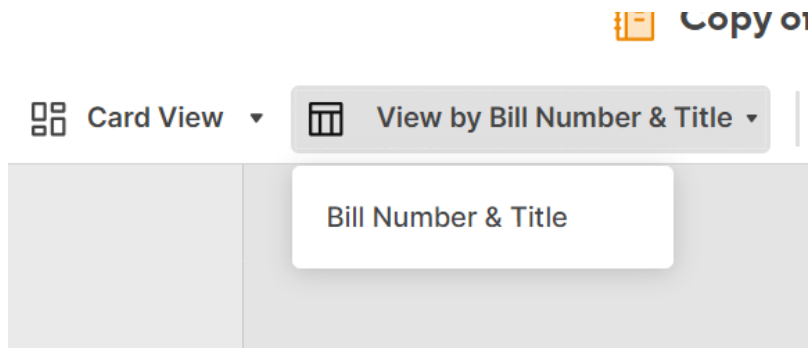
Smartsheets arbitrarily assigns what columns I can sort by in Card view – I have no control over those options. I'm looking for a way that I can decide what groupings to use in Card view.

Example 1: This is a report and I want to group by Internal Lead like the grid view below:

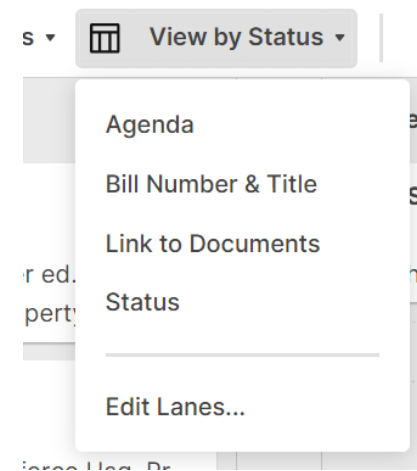
However, when I go into Card View, this is the only option I am given for grouping:



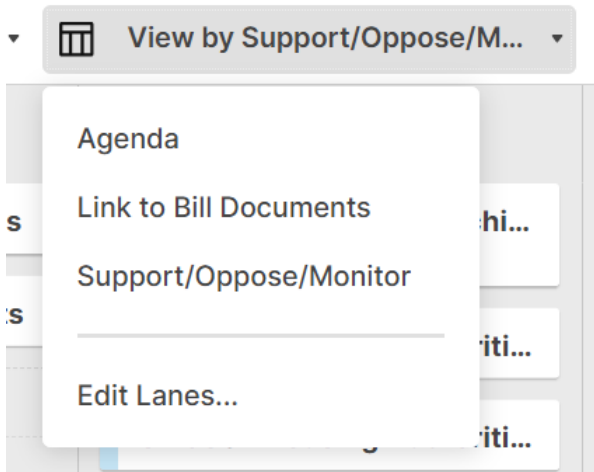
Example 2: This is in a sheet. I want to group by the Status column, but am not given that option in Card View (please note that both of these columns in both examples are text/number columns). This is what I want, but when I uploaded this spreadsheet, Smartsheets still arbitrarily gave me this option. When I did it a second time, this view was not available:

That said, these are the options given to me. I really don't need a view by "link to documents" and why is that even there? How did SS decide that was an option? Can I get rid of that?



Example 2 continued: so when I uploaded my spreadsheet into a NEW sheet in SSs, these are the Card views I'm given – I now do not have the option to sort by Status – and again, why is it wanting to sort by the documents link? It's literally a link to a website:



It's making me crazy. I don't know how SSs is just picking what my options are and why I seem to have no control over the views. I've gone into the settings and the only options I get are these – to just indicate which columns I want included on the cards – which is not what I want to do.
