Notice of the proposed traffic calming scheme at Old Clonsilla Road

A notice about Bus-Friendly flat-top ramp and appropriate road signage and markings where necessary was published on Monday 19th December 2022 inviting observations and submissions.

There were 4 submissions in favour of the work and 4 submissions against the work.

This work will include a new set of pedestrian lights and was necessitated by the large number of representations both FCC and local councillors were receiving about pedestrians crossing at the dangerous bend on the Old Clonsilla Road because a section of the path has been blocked off. This unfortunately necessitated the removal of a small number of trees to improve sightlines.

The work has commenced and although it is not an option that anyone would want, the safety of pedestrians must come first.
