SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT BYE-LAWS, 2009

DRAFT

Galway City Council (hereinafter referred to as ‘the City Council’) in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 46 of the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961), as inserted by Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 (No. 7 of 1994), Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), and with the consent of the National Roads Authority, and having consulted with the Commissioner of the Garda Siochána, hereby makes the following bye-laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative area of the City of Galway.

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the **Galway City Council Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws, 2009**.
2. These bye-laws shall commence on the _____
3. In these bye-laws:

“the Act of 1961” means the Road Traffic Act, 1961 (No. 24 of 1961);

“the Act of 1993” means the Roads Act, 1993 (No. 14 of 1993);

“the Act of 1994” means the Road Traffic Act, 1994 (No. 7 of 1994);

“the Act of 2004” means the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004);

“distance” means distance measured along the centre line of the road;

“national road” has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;

“perimeter road” means a road on and along the roadway of which there runs the boundary of a city, a borough, or a town and shall be considered as being within such boundary for the purposes of these bye-laws;

“road” means a public road.

4. Eighty kilometres per hour shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on roads specified in the First Schedule to these Bye-Laws.
5. One hundred kilometres per hour shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on roads specified in the Second Schedule to these Bye-Laws.
6. Sixty kilometres per hour shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on roads specified in the Third Schedule to these Bye-Laws.
7. Fifty kilometres per hour shall be the speed limit for mechanically propelled vehicles on roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to these Bye-Laws.
8. Regulation 2 of the First Schedule and Regulation 9 of the Third Schedule of the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (County Borough of Galway and County of Galway) Regulations, 1987, are hereby rescinded.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Roads in the City of Galway in respect of which a special speed limit of 80 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

The following roads:

- (i) The Headford Road (National Road N84) from a point 953 metres north of its junction with Bóthar an Chóiste northwards towards Headford to a point 50 metres north east of its junction with Ballindooley/Castlegar Road junction at the City Boundary.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Roads in the City of Galway in respect of which a special speed limit of 100 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

The following roads:

- (i) Bóthar na dTreabh (National Road N6) from a point 80 metres east of its junction with the Morris Roundabout (Ballybaan) eastwards to Lynch Roundabout (Ballybrit) and south eastwards to the Martin Roundabout (Doughiska).
- (ii) Eastern Approach Road (National Road N6) from its junction with the Martin Roundabout (Doughiska) eastwards for a distance of 984 metres to the City Boundary.

THIRD SCHEDULE

Roads in the City of Galway in respect of which a special speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

The following roads:

- (i) The Headford Road (National Road N84) from a point 177 metres north of its junction with Bóthar an Chóiste northwards towards Headford for a distance of 776 metres.

FOURTH SCHEDULE

Roads in the City of Galway in respect of which a special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour is prescribed.

The following roads:

- (i) The N17 (Tuam Road) from the N17/Parkmore Village junction to the Galway City boundary 1,060 metres north of the N17/Parkmore Village junction.
- (ii) The L1005 (Coolagh Road) from a point 90 metres north of Carrig Bán estate junction for 1,415 metres to the junction with L1006 (Monument Road).
- (iii) The L1006 (Monument Road) from its junction with L1005 (Coolagh Road) for 1,677 metres to the City boundary at Menlo.
- (iv) The L51516 (Monument Road) from the City boundary at Ballindooley for 625 metres to the N84 (Headford Road) Ballindooley Crossroads.
