

Open a NKS file with HxD

These symbols ~ ... means that a page start or change.

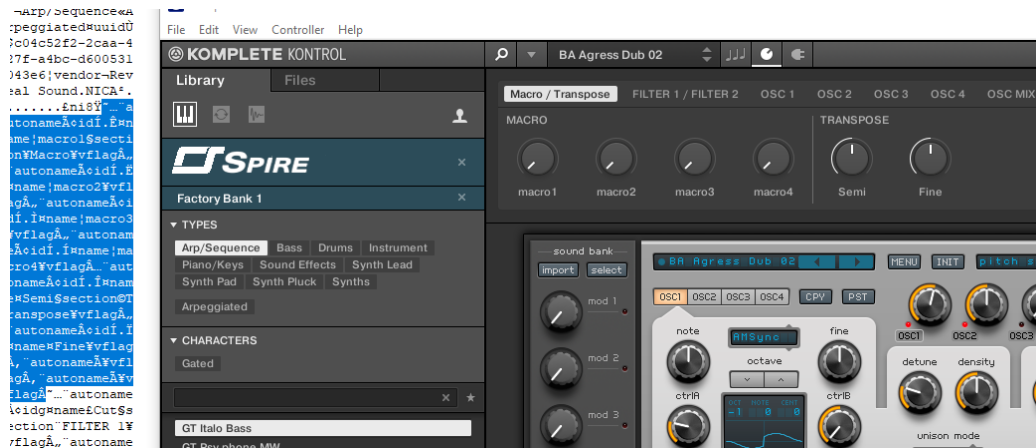
As you can see, first is the knob name and then the page name, followed by the rest of knobs

**\$section** = page name

**“autonameÃcidîname** =mapped knob name

**Semi\$section** = subpage

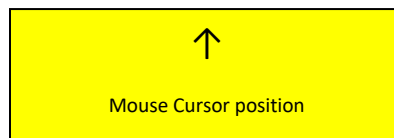

In the example below we will move the **FILTER 1 / FILTER 2** page to the top and make it first

(As an example file I use the “GT Italo Bass.nks f” from Spire Factory Soundbank 1

1. Mark the text that corresponds to the page (see Picture 2)
2. Right click → Cut
3. Move the mouse cursor to the start of first page | ~ ... and press right click → paste insert



4. Do not worry because the text became red (picture 3). It means that we make changes to file
5. Hit Save button on HxD
6. Rescan your library to see the changes (picture 4)
