New Terms or Concepts

District Matching – Matching a constituent to their individual district or ward in a county or city. This enables Convio to identify the constituent's individual representative on a County or City Council and to send the constituent's messages to only their councilmember and not all councilmembers for alerts that target their council.

Overview

Local Advocacy will now be facilitated with the addition of over 48,000 officials of county and municipal governments. These officials include both elected leaders and other decision makers like city managers. This data covers over 3000 counties and 3500 cities in the US.

In release that will ship in Spring 2011, Convio is also planning to offer constituent matching at the district level for 10-20 of the largest cities in the US, based on population. This will enable constituents in cities like DC and New York to be matched to their individual councilmembers. Over time, we plan to offer district matching for up to 200 cities and counties.

Key Features & Benefits

Features

- Ability to target alerts to more than 48,800 county/municipal officials
- District matching for 10-20 cities initially, and growing to ~200 over time
- New Constituent 360 Field for Municipality
- New Constituent 360 Groups for Municipal ResidentsWith MultiCenter, centers can be restricted to one or more counties or municipalities

Benefits

- Ability to perform advocacy campaigns at the local level
- Easier email targeting and conditional content for constituents at the local level.

Use Scenarios

Organization Targets a Local City Council (where district matching is available – planned for release in Spring 2011)

• The American Health Society (AHS) follows decision making at the local level. The New York City Council is performing an annual review of the NY City Budget and considering a cut to funding for city-wide public health clinics. AHS wants to mobilize their constituents to protect the funding for these clinics.

Ryan, an administrator for the AHS configures an alert that targets the NY City Council and the Mayor of NYC. He selects the NY City Council as the target of his alert in the Target Selection Interface and specifies that all messages should be delivered by email/webform. In order to drive activists to his alert, Ryan then configures an email to be sent to constituents who live in New York City by selecting the New York City group in municipal residents. Constituents are sent to take action on the alert; when they click the send message button, their message is sent *to their individual council member* and the Mayor.

Organization Targets a Local City Council (where district matching is not available)

The American Health Society (AHS) follows decision making at the local level. The Montgomery County, MD Council is
performing an annual review of their budget and considering a cut to funding for health education classes in the county
schools. AHS wants to mobilize their constituents to protect the funding for these classes.

Ryan, an administrator for the AHS configures an alert that targets the Montgomery County Council and County Executive. He selects the Montgomery County Council and County Exec as the targets of his alert in the Target Selection Interface and specifies that all messages should be delivered by email/webform. In order to drive activists to his alert, Ryan then configures an email to be sent to constituents who live in Montgomery County, MD by selecting the Montgomery County group in county resident's category. Constituents are sent to take action on the alert; when they click the send message button, their message is sent **to all council members** and the county executive.

Considerations for Clients

- When targeting officials in cities/counties where district matching is not available, constituents will be matched to the city or county and alerts that target the full council (or council equivalent) will be sent to all members of the council. If a 2-step alert is configured, constituents would be able to select their individual council member to receive the message.
- When targeting officials in cities/counties where district matching is not available, only constituents who live in the county/city will be able to take action
- When targeting officials in cities/counties where district matching is available, constituents will be matched to their
 individual representative on the council and constituent matching will be enforced meaning non-constituents will not be
 able to send messages to officials who do not represent them

Feature Configuration

The Local Data feature is available for an additional fee. When you purchase local data, Convio will configure your site; there is no extra configuration that needs to be done.

Using Local Data

Using local data in Action Alerts

In the first User Story above, AHS wants to drive its constituents to respond to an action alert that targets the New York City Council.

- 1. To create the action alert, click **Advocacy > Action Alert**.
- 2. Click Create Alert. The Create Action Alert page displays.
