This document describes the feature "Automated Pledge Recalculation", explains how to configure and use it, and offers tips for taking full advantage of its benefits. Please visit the <u>release resource center</u> to read more about the exciting features in this release.

OVERVIEW

Prior to this release, if a donor overpaid or underpaid a pledge payment, administrators had to manually adjust the payment schedule for the gift. For example, let's say a donor has pledged \$10.00 a month for six months. On the third month, they send in a check for \$20.00 instead of \$10.00. Should the next payment be cancelled and then resume two months later? Should the next payment resume as usual, but cancel the last payment? Or should the remaining number of payments be reduced by an equal amount totaling \$10.00?

The Luminate CRM Automatic Pledge Recalculation feature will automatically recalculate the balance and remaining payment schedule during gift entry depending on what settings you have chosen. For example, you can configure Pledge Recalculation so that overpayments are deducted from the next installment or so the deduction is distributed among all the remaining installments. There are similar settings for underpayments as well.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

The system can automatically recalculate the remaining payments when donors overpay or underpay. The system also includes an improved interface for manually editing the entire payment schedule when the donors payment schedule is not something that can be set on an exact interval.

Features

 Organizations can configure the default behavior for how the system should recalculate the outstanding pledge payment schedule when a donor overpays or underpays their pledge payment compared to the current payment due amount.

Benefits

- The system will automatically recalculate the outstanding pledge payment schedule based on the system defaults for overpayment.
- The system will automatically recalculate the outstanding pledge payment schedule based on the system defaults for underpayment.
- Organizations can now choose from a number of options to automatically create the adjusted, outstanding, scheduled payments for underpayment and overpayment based on organization business process rules.
- Organizations can manually edit the payment schedule for a donor when their payment needs fall outside the default payment recalculation rule.

COMMON SCENARIOS

When a donor overpays or underpays a pledge installment, the remaining pledge payments are recalculated according to how you have configured the system. For example if a donor overpays, you can deduct the overpayment amount from the next payment, or deduct it evenly from all the remaining payments.

The following lists the different ways you can configure how pledge installments are recalculated when a donor overpays or underpays:

Default Overpayment Behavior

- Evenly Allocate Overpayment Among Remaining Payments
- Deduct Payment from the Next Installment
- Deduct Payment from the Final Installment

Default Underpayment Behavior

- Evenly Allocate Underpayment Among Remaining Payments
- Add Payment to the Next Installment
- Add the Remaining Balance to a New, Subsequent Payment
- Add New Installment to the End of the Schedule

Default Overpayment Behavior

Javier Bates committed to give ABC Health \$1200 in 2012 fulfilled through \$100 payments. Each \$100 Payment is made via a check that Javier sends in each month. His original payment schedule for a \$1200 annual pledge is as follows:

The following scenarios illustrate how Luminate CRM recalculates the payment schedule if Javier overpays. The payments are recalculated in different ways depending on how the **Pledge Installment Recalculation Defaults** page is configured. The options are **Evenly Allocate**, **Deduct from Next Installment**, and **Deduct from Final Installment**.

If you don't want the pledge installments to be recalculated, you can click **Disabled**.

Evenly Allocate

In January Javier sent us \$100, in February he sent us \$150 when only \$100 was due for this month. If you have selected **Evenly Allocate**, overpayment amounts are deducted evenly from the remaining pledge installments.

To evenly allocate a pledge payment that has been overpaid:

1. In the Pledge Installment Recalculation Details page, select Evenly Reallocate.



The overpayment is deducted from the remaining installments resulting in \$95.00 payments for the remaining installments.

Deduct Payment from the Next Installment

If you have selected **Deduct Payment from Next Installment(s)**, the overpayment amount is deducted from the next installment. If the overpayment amount is larger than the next installment, it will be deducted from subsequent payments until it is fully applied (this may result in the pledged being fully paid earlier than initially scheduled). In Javier's case, his February payment is reduced to \$50.00 and the payments after that remain the same.

1. In the Pledge Installment Recalculation Details page, select Deduct from Next Installment.

The overpayment is deducted from the next installments, resulting in a \$50.00 March payment and the other installments remain the same.

Deduct Payment from the Last Installment

If you have selected **Deduct Payment from Last Installment(s)**, the overpayment amount is deducted from the last installment. If the overpayment amount is larger than the last installment, it will be deducted from the payment before the last payment until it is fully applied (this may result in the pledged being fully paid earlier than initially scheduled). Lets' say Javier pays \$225.00 in Feb. His December payment is removed from the payment schedule (he will only have 11 installments instead of 12), and his November payment is reduced to \$75.00.

1. In the Pledge Installment Recalculation Details page, select Deduct from Next Installment.

Fully deduct the overpayment amount from the final and each prior installment until fully applied. This may allow the pledge to be fulfilled earlier than originally planned.
No default overpayment recalculation behavior.

The overpayment is so large, that the final installment is removed, and the final payment is reduced to \$75.00.
 The pledge will be paid off in 11 installments now instead of 12.

Note: If you don't want the pledge installments to be recalculated, select Disabled.

Evenly Allocate

Let's say that Javier sends in a payment for \$50 when \$100 is due. If you have selected **Evenly Allocate**, the underpayment amount (\$50) will be added evenly to the remaining pledge installments.

To evenly allocate a pledge payment that has been overpaid:

1. In the **Pledge Installment Recalculation Details** page, select **Evenly Reallocate**.

Evenly distribute the new, larger balance across all remaining installments.
Add to next installment(s)
Add an additional installment on the same date as the underpaid installment to the pledge for the remaining balance to the end of the pledge.
Add remaining balance to new subsequent payment
Add the underpayment amount to a new subsequent installment. The new installment will be for the remaining balance and have the same close date as the updated installment.
C Add installment to end of schedule
Add an additional installment to the end of the pledge for the underpayment amount, extending the final pledge fulfillment date. The additional installment will inherit the schedule of the original pledge.

Add Underpayment Amount to the Next Installment

If you have selected **Add to Next Installment(s)**, the underpayment amount is added to the next installment. Using the previous example where Javier pays only \$50 for the February installment, his March payment is increased to \$150.

Add Remaining Balance to New Subsequent Payment

If you have selected **Add Remaining Balance to New Subsequent Payment**, the underpayment amount is added to the last installment in the payment schedule. Using the previous example where Javier pays only \$50 for the February installment, and new February installment is created for \$50 for the outstanding balance.

To add underpayment amounts to a new, subsequent payment:

1. In the Pledge Installment Recalculation Details page, select Add Remaining Balance to New Subsequent Payment.

Default underpayment behavior
C Evenly Reallocate
Evenly distribute the new, larger balance across all remaining installments.
O Add to next installment(s)
Add an additional installment on the same date as the underpaid installment to the pledge for the remaining balance to the end of the pledge.
Add remaining balance to new subsequent payment
Add the underpayment amount to a new subsequent installment. The new installment will be for the remaining balance and have the same close date as the updated installment.
C Add installment to end of schedule
Add an additional installment to the end of the pledge for the underpayment amount, extending the final pledge fulfillment date. The additional installment will inherit the schedule of the original pledge.

Manually Recalculating Pledge Installments
