Overview

This feature enhancement lets clients who use both Convio Online Marketing (COM) and Convio Common Ground (CG) use the standard Common Ground Connector to sync custom fields within a donation record in COM to custom fields in the CG opportunity record. Prior to this release, the ability to sync custom fields in COM and CG existed only within the constituent record. After the Convio Fall 2010 release becomes generally available, custom data field sync through the standard CG connector will be possible for both constituent and donation records.

With this feature enhancement, clients who currently use custom fields either in their COM or CG instance will have the ability to access data contained within those custom fields in both systems.

The client will have a user interface for defining custom field mappings by specific field name.

Key Features & Benefits

Features

• Ability to use the standard CG connector to sync custom donation data fields in COM and custom opportunity record fields in CG.

Benefits

• Custom donation record data fields can be shared between COM and CG. Any custom information specific to the donation record your organization may have created for use alongside the standard data elements can now be made available in both systems.

Considerations for Clients

• Field mappings can be created between custom fields in COM and custom fields in CG only – standard data fields cannot be included in any custom field mappings.

• Custom donation record field mappings must be 1 to 1 – one custom field in COM can be mapped to one custom data field in CG only. One-to-many mappings are not supported.

Feature Configuration

This feature enhancement is only for Common Ground data syncing and the one-to-one mapping it provides is one way, from COM to CG. Using the feature involves three distinct processes

- Configuring a custom opportunity field in Common Ground
- Configuring custom donation fields
- Creating custom donation fields

Configuring a Custom Opportunity Field in Common Ground

You need to create an opportunity field in CG to map to a custom donation field in COM. This configuration is performed under Setup > Customize. In that section, click Opportunities and Fields and then click the New button to define a new custom opportunity field.

NOTE: There is a ten minute caching delay before a new CG field will be available for mapping in COM.

Configuring Custom Donation Fields in COM:

Navigate to "Import/Export" under the Administrator Data Management menu. Click the "All Data Sync Operations" tab and then click the Edit action for "Convio Connector for Common Ground DataSync." Click Step 4 in the process navigator: Map Custom Donation Fields. Note: this assumes you have set up a custom opportunity field in Common Ground.

Creating Custom Donation Fields and Mapping Them to Common Ground Donation Fields:

Navigate to "Donation Management" under Fundraising and either edit an existing form or create a new one.

Edit the Donation Form and create a new custom data element to include in the form. In the popup window for the custom element, there is a new step, 5. Common Ground Donation Field. Choose the Common Ground opportunity field to which you will map your custom field.

5. Common Ground Donation Field

Select the field on Common Ground to which you want to map this field.



Save this custom field and add it to your donation form. That will ensure that it is added to any data sync.
