
General Information

How do I download the Canvas Parent app on my Android device?

You can download the Canvas Parent app from the Google Play Store onto your Android device.


The images in this lesson are shown for a phone display. Unless otherwise noted, tablet displays mirror the same steps.


Open your Android device and tap the **Play Store** icon.

In the app menu, tap the **Search** icon.


Search for App



In the **Search** field, enter Canvas Parent [1].


When the app appears, tap the name [2].

Install App




Tap the **Install** button.

Verify app download and installation.

Open App



When the app finishes download and installation, access the app immediately by tapping the **Open** button.

You can also open the app on your Android home screen by tapping the **Canvas Parent** icon.

How do I create an account in the Canvas Parent app on my Android device?


In the Canvas Parent app, you can create a Canvas Observer account to view student course information. If you already have an account, you can [log in to the Parent app](#).

To link yourself to a student, you will need to enter a student-specific pairing code that will link you to the student. Pairing codes are valid for seven days. Students can [generate pairing codes](#) from their User Settings.

Depending on institution permissions, admins and instructors may also be able to generate pairing codes. For more information on pairing codes, view the [Pairing Codes - Frequently Asked Questions resource document](#).


Note: If you are not able to create an account, your school has not enabled self-registration. Please contact your school to create your account.







If you previously logged into the app, your Canvas URL displays. To log in again, tap the Canvas URL button [1].

If you previously changed users in the app, to log in again, you can tap the user's account [2].

Enter Login Credentials




After you've found your institution, the Canvas URL displays at the top of the screen [1]. Enter your email [2] and password [3]. Then tap the **Log In** button [4].

If you don't know your password, tap the **Forgot Password?** link [5].

Notes:

- The Canvas email field credential varies according to institution. Some institutions may require a username or account number.
- If your Canvas mobile login page does not show the Forgot Password? link, contact your institution if you need to reset your password.
- If your institution requires you to log in to Canvas using their authentication system, you will be redirected to your institution's login page.

How do I log in to the Parent app on my Android Device with a QR code?


Once you [download the Canvas Parent app](#) from the Google Play Store, you can use the app to log in to your Canvas account.

You can generate a unique QR code from your Canvas web browser to quickly log into the app. This method uses your credentials from the QR code to log you into the app. The QR code is located in your account profile (User Navigation Menu).

If you do not want to locate your Canvas URL every time you log in to Canvas, learn how to [switch to another user account](#).






How do I use the Canvas Parent app on my Android device?

The Canvas Parent app lets you view a student's course events, upcoming assignments, and grades. You can also add and view multiple students in your account.

Notes:


- The Canvas Parent app uses your device's settings to set the time zone used within the app.
- When creating an account, you can link one observed student in the Parent app. Learn how to [link additional students](#) in the Parent app.
- You cannot remove observed students in the Parent app.
- To change the language displayed in the Parent app, select a language in Canvas from a web browser, log out of the Parent app, and log in again.





How do I clear my cache in the Parent app on my Android device?

You can clear your cache in the Canvas Parent app on your Android device. Clearing your cache will clear all information on your device that is specific to the app, including login details and app settings.


You may want to use a cache reset if you experience errors when logging in to the app. Because a cache reset will remove app information from your device, you may want to try resetting your password or uninstalling the app first.


Enter a brief description of your problem in the **Subject** field [1]. The Parent app automatically includes your Canvas URL and the Parent app version you are using.

Compose your message with an explanation of your problem in the **Description** field [2].

Specify the impact of this problem using options in the **How is this affecting you?** drop-down menu [3].


When you are ready to submit your report, tap the **Send** link [4].

Submit a Feature Idea



If you have a recommendation for improving the app, or to request a feature in the app, tap the **Submit a Feature Idea** link. You can send an email with your update request to the Canvas mobile support team from your user account email address. The email will auto-populate with your contact and Parent app details.

Share Your Love for the App




To leave a review of the Canvas Parent app, tap the **Share your love for the app** link. The app will open the Play Store where you can leave feedback.

If you use Canvas in more than one account (Canvas URL), you can change between accounts on your device without having to log out of the app.



To link your account, you will need a student pairing code provided by your student, their instructor, or an admin from your student's institution.












Assignments or events on other dates are indicated by a dot below the date. Multiple dots indicate multiple assignments or events, which can be viewed by tapping the date [2].

You can manage the courses displayed in the calendar by tapping the **Calendars** link.




How do I create a reminder for an assignment or event in the Canvas Parent app on my Android device?

You can set course assignment and event reminders from a course page or from the Calendar.

When setting a reminder, you can select the date and time that you would like to receive the reminder.


Reminders are sent as push notifications to your device.


